EXAMPLE 1 (APL Only)

Husband: \$5,000 net monthly income
Wife: \$1,500 net monthly income
No Children

OLD GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI: \$5,000 (76.92%)
Wife's NMI: (\$1,500) (23.08%)
Difference: \$3,500
x40%
Husband's APL Obligation: **\$1,400**

NEW GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI: \$5,000
x33%
→ \$1,650 (60.77%)
Wife's NMI: \$1,500
x40%
→ (\$600) (39.23%)
Husband's APL Obligation **\$1,050**

EXAMPLE 2 (Child Support & APL)

Father: \$5,000 net monthly income
Mother: \$1,500 net monthly income
Two Children & 50/50 Custody
Daycare: \$750 per month paid by Mother

OLD GUIDELINES:

Child Support:

Father's NMI:	\$5,000	(76.92%)
Mother's NMI:	\$1,500	(23.08%)
Combined NMI:	\$6,500	
BCSO:	\$1,591	
	<u>x76.92%</u>	
Father's CSO:	\$1,223.80	
Adjustment 50/50 Custody:	(\$315.98)	
Father's Share of Daycare:	\$449.98	(76.92% of \$750 per month less adjustment for tax credit)
Father's Total Child Support:	\$1,357.80	

APL:

Father's NMI:	\$5,000
Mother's NMI:	(\$1,500)
Father' CSO w/o 50/50 adj.:	<u>(\$1,673.78)</u>
Difference:	\$1,826.22
	<u>x30%</u>
APL:	\$547.87

Total:

Child Support:	\$1,357.80
<u>APL:</u>	<u>\$547.87</u>
Total:	\$1,905.67

EXAMPLE 3 (APL Only)

Husband: \$10,000 net monthly income
Wife: \$5,000 net monthly income
No Children

OLD GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI: \$10,000 (66.67%)
Wife's NMI: (\$5,000) (33.33%)
Difference: \$5,000
x40%
Husband's APL Obligation: **\$2,000**

NEW GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI: \$10,000
x33%
→ \$3,300
Wife's NMI: \$5,000
x40%
→ (\$2,000)
Husband's APL Obligation **\$1,300**

EXAMPLE 4 (Child Support & APL)

Father: \$10,000 net monthly income
Mother: \$5,000 net monthly income
Two Children
Daycare: \$2,000 per month paid by Mother

OLD GUIDELINES:

Child Support:

Father's NMI:	\$10,000	(66.67%)
<u>Mother's NMI:</u>	<u>\$5,000</u>	<u>(33.33%)</u>
Combined NMI:	\$15,000	
BCSO:	\$2,586	
	<u>x66.67%</u>	
Father's CSO:	\$1,724.09	
<u>Father's Share of Daycare:</u>	<u>\$1,266.73</u>	(66.67% of \$2,000 per month less adjustment for tax credit)
Father's Total Child Support:	\$2,990.82	

APL:

Father's NMI:	\$10,000
Mother's NMI:	(\$5,000)
<u>Father's CSO:</u>	<u>(\$2,990.82)</u>
Difference:	\$2,009.18
	<u>x30%</u>
APL:	\$602.75

Total:

Child Support:	\$2,990.82
<u>APL:</u>	<u>\$602.75</u>
Total:	\$3,593.57

Adjusted NMI:	→	<u>\$6,000 (40%)</u>
Combined NMI:		\$15,000
BCSO:	\$2,586	
	<u>x60%</u>	
Father's CSO:	\$1,551.60	
<u>Father's Share of Daycare:</u>	<u>\$1,140</u>	(60% of \$2,000 per month less adjustment for tax credit)

Father's Total Child Support: \$2,691.60

Total:

Child Support:	\$2,691.60
<u>APL:</u>	<u>\$1,000</u>
Total:	\$3,691.60

EXAMPLE 5 (APL Only)

Husband: \$25,000 net monthly income
Wife: \$5,000 net monthly income
No Children

OLD GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI:	\$25,000 (83.33%)
Wife's NMI:	<u>(\$5,000) (16.67%)</u>
Difference:	\$20,000
	<u>x40%</u>
Husband's APL Obligation:	\$8,000

NEW GUIDELINES:

Husband's NMI:	\$25,000	
	<u>x33%</u>	
	→	\$8,250
Wife's NMI:	\$5,000	
	<u>x40%</u>	
	→	<u>(\$2,000)</u>
Husband's APL Obligation		\$6,250

EXAMPLE 6 (Child Support & APL)

Father: \$25,000 net monthly income
Mother: \$5,000 net monthly income
Two Children
Tuition: \$25,000 per year paid by Father

OLD GUIDELINES:

Child Support:

Father's NMI: \$25,000 (83.33%)

Mother's NMI: \$5,000 (16.67%)

Combined NMI: \$30,000

BCSO: \$3,902

x83.33%

Father's CSO: \$3,251.54

Father's Share of Tuition: (\$347.29) (16.7% of \$25,000 per year expressed monthly)

Father's Total Child Support: \$2,904.25

APL:

Father's NMI: \$25,000

Mother's NMI: (\$5,000)

Father's CSO: (\$2,904.25)

Difference: \$17,095.75

x30%

APL: \$5,128.73

Total:

Child Support: \$2,904.25

APL: \$5,128.73

Total: \$8,032.98
