Mr. Hubbard is a Senior Attorney with the City of Philadelphia Law Department's Civil Rights Unit. His primary practice area is in Civil Rights litigation, defending the City of Philadelphia, and its officials and employees, in Section 1983 civil rights actions. He also defends the City, and its officials and employees, in state court civil actions. Mr. Hubbard's legal professional experience includes ten years as staff counsel for The Philadelphia Housing Authority, providing legal counsel in transactional and regulatory matters, as well as representing PHA, its officials and employees in administrative hearings, landlord-tenant actions, premises liability litigation, employment litigation, Civil Rights litigation, and appeals. He also served three years on active duty as a naval judge advocate in the United States Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps as criminal defense counsel and Legal Assistance Division Officer. Mr. Hubbard earned a Juris Doctor degree from The Norman Adrian Wiggins School of Law (Campbell University), in North Carolina; and earned a bachelor's degree from Saint Joseph's College, in Philadelphia, PA. He studied international law at the University of Notre Dame London Law Centre, in London, England.
